

## 湯川秀樹 発表論文リスト

湯川秀樹は 54 編の論文（ノーベル賞講演等を含む）を発表した。そのうちリストの最初の 16 編は大阪帝国大学時代（1933–1939）に執筆された。論文 1 は、中間子を提唱しノーベル賞対象となった歴史的な論文である。1938 年（昭和 13 年）、湯川は主論文（論文 1）と参考論文 9 編（論文 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 8, 9, 10, 11）からなる博士学位論文を提出し、大阪帝国大学より第 584 号の学位が湯川に授与された。
